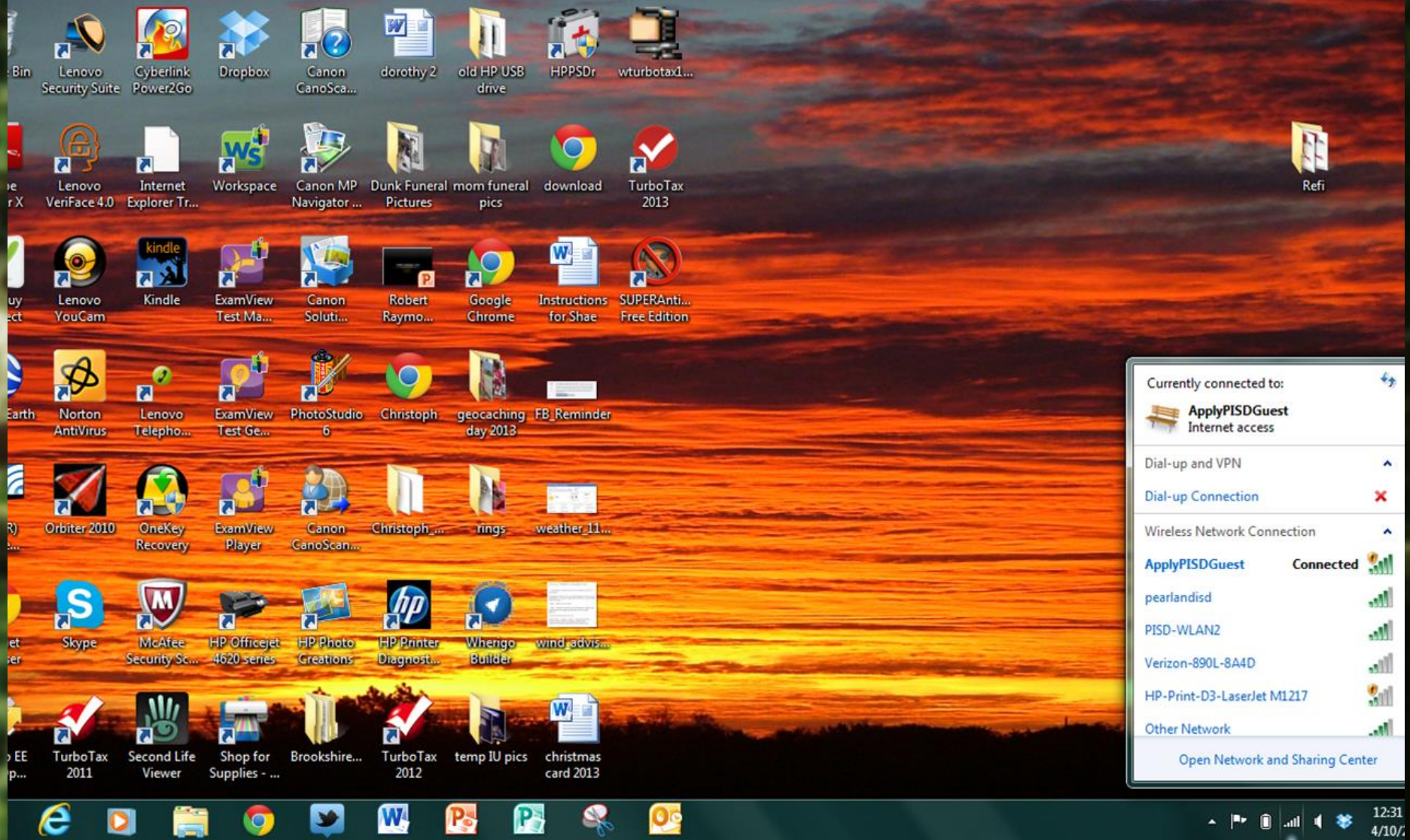

Wifi Setup Instructions



Open the networks listing and connect to “ApplyPISDGuest”



This guest portal is to request access to the Pearland ISD wireless network. Your guest username and password for accessing the "pearlandisd" WiFi network will be sent by text to your cell phone after completing the registration from. Guest internet access will be limited. Pearland staff and students should use their existing login information to gain full access to "pearlandisd" WiFi network and should not apply for the guest accounts.

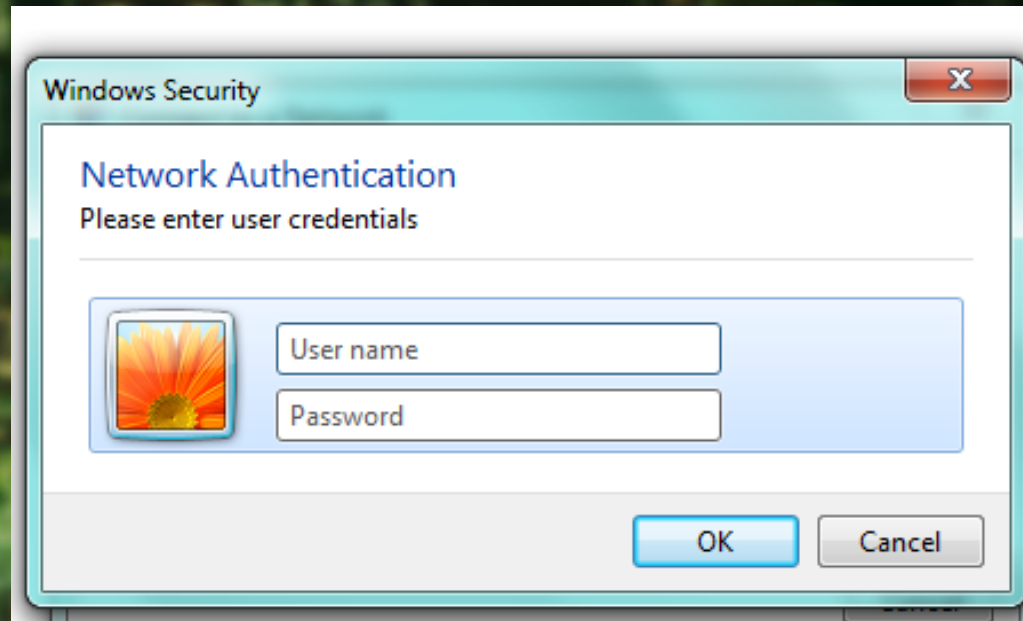

Connect

Pearland Independent School District provides a variety of electronic communications systems for educational purposes. The electronic communications systems are defined as the District's network (including the wireless network), servers, computer workstations, mobile technologies, peripherals, applications, databases, online resources, Internet access, and any other technology designated for use by students, including all new technologies as they become available. This also includes any access to the Pearland ISD electronics system while on or near school property, in school vehicles and at school-sponsored events, and includes the appropriate use of district technology resources via off-campus remote access. Please note that the Internet is a network of many different types of communication and information networks and is part of the district's electronic communications systems.

Electronic Communication Devices: Bring Your Own Device

We are excited about the new learning opportunities available through Bring Your Own Device. It is our goal that students and teachers will collaborate in creating engaging learning experiences using technology. Students may bring their own device and utilize personal electronic communication devices at school and school activities. Students may use these devices in the classroom when the teacher deems them appropriate for educational purposes. All devices must remain silent or be put away unless being used within a lesson during class time. Students may not use devices during elective classes or non-instructional times, such as passing periods, lunch and before/after school.

Bring your own Device includes any privately owned device that enhances the learning experience.

All devices should be clearly labeled with student's full name. It may also be a good idea to keep a record of the device's serial number.

When you see the screen, enter your guest username and password, click the checkbox, and then click "Connect." You should now have access to our network.
